1. Data in columns 1 - 6 are collected by the Building Societies Association from institutions providing both the cash and stakeholder CTF. In March, these are made up of 13 building societies: Britannia, Cambridge, Chorley & District, Earl Shilton, Furness, Hanley Economic, Ipswich, Leeds, Monmouthshire, Nationwide, Shepsed, Skipton and Yorkshire. The other providers included above are Abbey National plc, Clockwise Credit Union, Leeds City Credit Union, and Methodist Chapel Aid Ltd.
2. Data in columns 7 & 8 are collected by HM Revenue and Customs from all providers and is published on a quarterly basis. Data in column 7 are the number of vouchers issued at the start of the quarter; data in column 8 are the number of those in column 7 that have been opened by parents by the end of the quarter (except for Q4 2007 which goes up to 15 December 2007).
